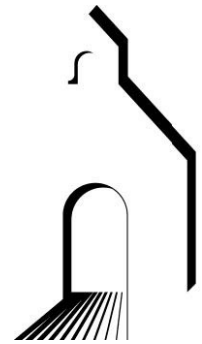

MISSION

The Holt Education Foundation shall provide educational opportunities for establishing innovative programs and resources that will challenge students and staff members to achieve their full potential, now and in the future.

PURPOSE

The Holt Education Foundation is a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of Michigan as a method of providing private support to enhance the Holt Public Schools' programs and services beyond the limits of normal tax support.

WHERE DOES THE MONEY COME FROM?

Funds to support the Foundation's efforts are obtained through individual and corporate tax-deductible contributions. Donations can be general in nature or can be given to support a particular project. The Foundation sponsors the following fundraising events each year:

WHO DECIDES HOW THE MONEY IS SPENT?

The Foundation's Board of Trustees is a volunteer group of private citizens who meet regularly to provide direction for its efforts. Requests for project funding can be initiated by Holt Public Schools' staff, parents, students, and other citizens and community leaders. The Foundation Board will consider all requests and fund projects based on established priorities and available resources. Since 1994 over \$400,000 has been awarded in projects and scholarships.

WHAT NEEDS WILL THE FOUNDATION SUPPORT?

The Foundation considers projects that will:

- ◆ Improve two-way communication between home and school.
- ◆ Expand the use of technology in teaching and learning.
- ◆ Increases library/media center resources.
- ◆ Stimulate innovative programs through mini-grants.



- ◆ Provide opportunities for staff, students and the community to access resources to improve student achievement and self esteem.
- ◆ Award the Holt Education Foundation's Margaret Livensparger Scholarship to a Holt High School graduate each year.
